## Re: Discounted tuition fees for GUATEFUTURO sponsored students

The University of Warwick and GUATEFUTURO have a longstanding collaborative agreement through which the University has welcomed a significant number of oustanding GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries into a wide variety of academic disciplines. These scholars have actively contributed and thrived as part of our student community.

In recognition of this long standing collaboration, a number of academic departments within the University have been providing substantial additional financial support to GUATEFURO beneficiaries. In particular, the departments of WMG (Warwick Manufacturing Group) - the largest multidisciplinary education and research department in the Faculty of Science, and WBS (Warwick Business School) - one of the largest business schools in Europe.

Both departments would like to formalise the financial support being provided through departmental tuition fee scholarships to GUATEFUTURO scholars by offering the following:

- WMG at the University of Warwick will provide scholarships worth 50% of the tuition fees to all GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries studying on full-time Masters courses within the WMG Department:

- 2. Warwick Business School will provide scholarships of 50% of the tuition fees to all GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries studying on full-time Masters courses (including full time MBA) within the Warwick Business School:
  - MSc Business with Accounting & Finance
  - MSc Business with Consulting
  - MSc Business with Marketing
  - MSc Business with Operations Management
  - MSc International Business
  - MSc Business Analytics
  - MSc Management
  - MSc Human Resource Management & Employment Relations
  - MSc Management of Information Systems & Digital Innovation
  - MSc Marketing & Strategy
  - MSc Finance
  - MSc Accounting & Finance
  - MSc Finance & Economics
  - MSc Financial Mathematics
  - MSc Business & Finance
  - MBA
- 3. Additionally, the University of Warwick will provide scholarships worth 20% of the tuition fees for GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries studying on:
  - a. any other Master's courses across the University
  - b. any PhD programme at the University.

In order to be eligible for these awards, scholars should have an unconditional offer of a place on full time postgraduate taught or research course delivered at the University of Warwick for entry in 2019/20, 2020/21 or 2021/22.
