Amendment of Agreement

I refer to the agreement between Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (**RMIT**) and Fundación GuateFuturo (**you, GuateFuturo**) dated 12 December 2018 (**Agreement**).

In consideration of the mutual promises contained in this letter, with effect on and from the date this letter is signed by the last party to execute it (**Effective Date**), the parties agree to amend the Agreement as set out in this letter.

The following clause is inserted:

4a. RMIT will provide a 50% discount on tuition fees for two (2) eligible student for two (2) years of a Master by Coursework program. GUATEFUTURO will nominate eligible student to receive discounted tuition fees under this clause 4a.

Unless context requires otherwise, terms defined in the Agreement have the same meaning in this letter. All other terms of the Agreement remain unchanged, and in full force and effect. If there is any inconsistency between this letter and the Agreement, this letter prevails in relation to its subject matter. Each party must do all things and execute all documents as necessary to give the full effect to the amendments in this letter. This letter and the Agreement constitute the entire agreement between the parties in relation to their subject matter, and supersede any contract, arrangement, condition or representation in relation to such subject matter prior to the Effective Date. A party may execute this letter by signing any counterpart and returning it electronically, including by PDF.
