Re: Discounted tuition fees for GUATEFUTURO sponsored students

The University of Warwick and GUATEFUTURO have a longstanding collaborative agreement through which the University has welcomed a significant number of oustanding GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries into a wide variety of academic disciplines. These scholars have actively contributed and thrived as part of our student community.

In recognition of this long standing collaboration, the University of Warwick has been providing substantial financial support to GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries and would like to continue this provision into the future as follows:

- WMG (Warwick Manufacturing Group) and WBS (Warwick Business School) to provide scholarships worth 50% of the tuition fees to all GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries studying on full-time master's courses within these two departments.
- The University of Warwick to provide scholarships worth 20% of the tuition fees for GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries studying on any other master's in any other department.
- The University of Warwick to also provide scholarships worth 20% of the tuition fees for GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries pursuing PhD studies in any department at the University.

In order to be eligible for these awards, scholars should have an unconditional offer of a place on a full time postgraduate taught or research course delivered at the University of Warwick for entry in 2022/23, 2023/24, 2024/25 or 2025/26. There is no restriction on the number of GUATEFUTURO beneficiaries joining any programme.
